

# HOT SPOT

## Carpet Spotter, Pre-spray & Bonnet Buffing Solution

Hot Spots combination of detergents and emulsified natural solvents, effectively removes most types of petroleum based soils, animal matter, proteins, starches, and sugars. Full strength or diluted 1:1, Hot Spot is a highly effective spotter. Diluted to 3 ozs. per gallon of water, Hot Spot is effective as a carpet pre-spray or bonnet buffing solution even on heavily soiled carpets. When used in a routine bonnet buffing program, Hot Spot removes stains and soil from heavy traffic areas. Hot Spot is non-toxic, non-corrosive and biodegradable.



### APPLICATION & MAINTENANCE

Although this product is safe for use on most types of industrial carpets, spot pre-testing for color fastness is advisable.

**For Use As A Spotter:** Use full strength or dilute 1:1 with cold water. Thoroughly vacuum the area to be cleaned. Scrape off any hardened soil with a putty knife or scraper. Using a coarse spray apply the material directly onto the heavily soiled area or stain with a solvent resistant trigger or pressurized sprayer. Allow the material to work for approximately 3-5 minutes. Removal of stubborn stains may require gentle scrubbing with a medium stiff bristled brush in a circular motion. Proceed with normal extraction cleaning procedures.

**For Use As A Bonnet Buffing Solution:** Thoroughly vacuum the area to be cleaned. Dilute 3 ozs. of Hot Spot per gallon of water. Apply the solution to approximately 100 ft<sup>2</sup> of carpet in a coarse mist using a trigger or pressurized sprayer. Allow the solution to stand for 5 minutes to dissolve and loosen the soil. Soak two carpet bonnets in a bucket of clean water. Remove one bonnet from the bucket and wring out any excess water. Place the bonnet under a 175 Rpm floor machine. Begin cleaning by outlining the area to be cleaned and then continue using overlapping side to side strokes. As the bonnet becomes soiled, it should be turned over. When both sides become soiled the first bonnet should be rinsed out and returned to the bucket to soak while the cleaning procedure is continued with the second bonnet. This procedure should be repeated in a direction perpendicular to the first procedure.

**For Use As A Carpet Pre-Spray:** Thoroughly vacuum the area to be cleaned. Dilute 3 ozs. of Hot Spot per gallon of water. Apply the solution to the area to be extraction cleaned in a coarse mist using a trigger or pressurized sprayer. Allow the solution to stand for 5 minutes to dissolve and loosen the soil. Extraction clean using Perma New Life Extraction Cleaner per instructions on specification sheet or label.
